

School Leavers and Future Destinations

- There were a total of 31 leavers from your school during the previous academic year.
- 27 students from your school went on to HE/University overall.
- 19 students from your school went on to HE/University in the same country as your school and 8 went on to HE/University in other countries
- There were a total of 2700 leavers across all responding schools during the previous academic year.
- Of the 1444 school leavers from all 69 responding schools, 1356 (94%) in total went on to HE/University.
- Of these, 387 students (27%) went on to HE/University in the same country as the school and 969 students (67%) to HE/University in other countries. 88 students (6%) went on to take a gap year.
- Leavers from responding COBIS schools went on to a wide variety of UK Universities. Some of the top destinations include Bath Spa University (76 students), University College London (UCL) (18 students), Edinburgh, University of (15 students), King's College London (12 students) and Cambridge, University of (11 students).
- Of the 969 students who went on to HE/University in other countries, the most popular destination is United States (141 students), followed by Canada (47 students) and Australia (16 students).

School Development – Networking and Collaboration

- Responding schools expressed an interest in networking and collaboration in areas relating to school improvement and development.
 - The most popular areas of interest are Administration, CPD and Assessment.

Assessments/Examinations offered
