With iQTS you can train either in person or via remote technology and at schools in your region with no need to visit the UK.

iQTS: Need to know

- Train for one academic year full-time, or longer part-time
- · To find out how much iQTS costs, check with individual providers
- iQTS is **backed by the UK government**, valued by many international schools and will open doors all over the world



To apply for iQTS you will need to have:

- A bachelor's degree from a UK or non-UK university or other institution
- A maths qualification equivalent to GCSE grade 4
- A science qualification equivalent to GCSE grade
 4 for teaching children aged 3 to 11
- Excellent written and verbal English language skills with a minimum <u>IELTS</u> (ielts.org) score of 6.5

A GCSE is an academic qualification awarded for exams in England, usually taken at age 16.

You do not need any teaching experience or to be currently working in a school to apply for iQTS.

With iQTS, you'll automatically get **English qualified** teacher status (QTS) with no further fees or training. You'll then be qualified to teach in all English schools. You must have the right visa and immigration status and some schools will need you to complete an induction period.
