

COBIS Student Spotlight Terms and Conditions

- 1. Entries will be accepted from 2 March 2021 until 3pm BST on 31 March 2021.
- 2. All COBIS schools, including Applicant schools, are eligible to submit videos. Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school.
- 3. Three videos per school may be submitted. COBIS will accept the first three videos from a school and reserves the right to exclude subsequent submissions.
- 4. Videos must comply with the following rules:
 - Video will be submitted by a school.
 - Video will be no longer than 4 minutes.
 - Video will showcase student talent (individual or group).
 - Video will have been produced within academic year 2020/21.
 - Video will not contain dangerous activities or harm to any living creature.
 - Video will not contain any private and confidential information.
 - Video will only contain music/media for which the school has obtained copyright permission.
 - Video will be submitted via an entry form on the COBIS website.
- 5. Teachers should upload their entries to a video hosting site (e.g. YouTube, Vimeo, the school website etc.) and provide a URL to them on their entry form.
- 6. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason. Any entries received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 7. All communications will only be between COBIS and a lead teacher.
- 8. The chosen entries will be shared at the COBIS Annual Conference 2021 and may be uploaded to the COBIS website, YouTube channel and social media platforms.
- 9. Teachers will be notified of whether their entries will be showcased at the COBIS Annual Conference by email in April 2021.
- 10. If an entry is selected, COBIS will require the teacher to send the original video.
- 11. The student/group name, school name and video (including images of students) of the chosen entries will be shared at the COBIS Annual Conference 2021, on the COBIS website and social media, on the COBIS YouTube channel and in other COBIS-related publications. By submitting a video, the teacher confirms that the necessary permissions have been sought from students and/or their parents/guardians to publish the full name, school name/logo and video for such purposes.
